America's Plutocracy and the Need for Reform

America's political system is presidential, not parliamentary, as are most democracies in the world. It is not modern. Scandinavian politicians for example do not have to worry about raising money for reelection at all, because their form of democracy is differently structured. But America's is so old and so badly conceived that it needs a ton of money to pay for the TV ads to get politicians reelected. This abuse has become so bad today that US politicians are now stooges/puppets to corporations and lobby groups like AIPAC (the Jewish lobby in the US). America is no longer a democracy but rather a plutocracy (rule of the rich).
