

CULTURE BASHING THE DICTATORS

Abstract

The Chinese are now becoming rich enough to be able to afford to travel internationally. For the past decade (the 2000s) they have been spending their money on cars and apartments. Their next major purchases will be expensive (to the Chinese) overseas trips, to Europe, to the US, to Australia, etc. The Chinese government is predicting that by 2020 there will be about 100 million Chinese traveling internationally every year. This will create an opportunity for western globist multitis to put real moral pressure on these Chinese tourists to shake them into recognition of their culture's major inferiorities, so that they become ashamed of being Chinese and become motivated to modernize and civilize their culture. The globist multitis really want China to democratize, a fifth of humanity, and the "big, bad, backward, exception" with its brutal dictatorship that has killed about 70-80 million of its own citizens. 90% of people living outside of China, live in democracies. Western globist multitis can culture bash Chinese tourists, taunting them with comments such as "When are Chinese going to democratize?" "Do you Chinese still have over 1000 Laogai?" (i.e Chinese gulag-like slave labor camps for political prisoners (half to two million of them). "Why are you Chinese so politically

backward?” “When are you Chinese going to win a Nobel Prize?” “Are you Chinese tired of being third worlders?” “When are you Chinese going to throw out your mass murdering dictatorial leaders?” etc.

It is an empirical fact that democratic nations are far less likely to go to war with each other, so when China democratizes, the risk of war between the US and China goes right down. The US despises the Chinese dictatorship, for the same reasons as it hated the regimes of Hitler and Stalin. All three have killed multiple tens of millions of people. Globist multis encourage the active culture bashing of Chinese tourists (and citizens of other dictatorial regimes who travel to the democratic countries). These touring Chinese will then learn that the democratic world looks down on Chinese, as politically backward and brutal. This recognition, will jolt them into thinking about their own status and make them think about the inferiorities of their own culture, particularly about the dictatorial nature of their own government, and motivate them to change it, either by pushing it out of power in a “people power” putsch, or (preferably) forcing it to reform itself into a democratic party and competing in democratic elections. With a democratic China, and a more democratic Russia, the “big 5” (China, India, Europe, US, and Russia) can then play “bully” with the straggling dictatorships, and put real pressure on them to democratize, to ban the arms trade, to free up \$T2/year wasted on the global arms trade, and push for a global education system, to make everyone educated and much richer. Ridding the world of the last dictatorships is called “dedictation”. Democratizing China would be a major step in that direction. Individuals from democratic

countries can contribute to that goal by culture bashing Chinese tourists (and citizens of other dictatorial regimes) using the reasoning given above. The final goal of a fully (dedictated) democratic world is so attractive, and so much more warfree, that it motivates strongly the need for culture bashing against tourists of the dictatorial regimes.
